BY-LAW No. 185-2001

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, is further amended by deleting from Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, between the words “Rexleigh Drive” and “Roosevelt Road” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(Column 1 Road)	(Column 2 Side)	(Column 3 Between)	(Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Rolph Road	East	Adjacent to Rolph Road School	8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (School) except Saturday and Sunday

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, between the words “Plains Road” and “Rumsey Road” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(Column 1 Road)	(Column 2 Side)	(Column 3 Between)	(Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Rolph Road	East	Southvale Drive and Sutherland Drive	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
