**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 220-2001**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting Selkirk Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Part A of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Selkirk Street	Even	From Pape Avenue to the east end of Selkirk Avenue	20	All times

B. By inserting in Part P of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Selkirk Street	Even	From Pape Avenue to the east end of Selkirk Street	20	All times
