CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 229-2001

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, Section 441-1, Fire Services and Inspections.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto deems it necessary to amend Section 441-1, Fire Services and Inspections, of Chapter 441, Fees, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code to increase the fee for certain fire services and inspections and to establish a fee for non-emergency elevator incident responses,

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 441-1A of Chapter 441 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by inserting between the definitions of "MALICIOUS FALSE ALARM" and "NUISANCE FIRE ALARM" the following new definition:

NON-EMERGENCY ELEVATOR INCIDENT RESPONSE - A response to a building to free an individual from an elevator that is inoperative due to a mechanical failure, equipment malfunction or improper maintenance or installation of the elevator or any of its components, but does not include a response to free an individual who has urgent medical needs or has been placed in immediate danger as a result of the elevator being inoperative.

- 2. Items 26, 27 and 28 of Schedule A to Section 441-1 of Chapter 441 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by increasing the fee from \$300.00 to \$350.00.
- 3. Item 29 of Schedule A to Section 441-1 of Chapter 441of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by increasing the fee from \$120.00 to \$175.00.
- **4.** Schedule A to Section 441-1 of Chapter 441 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by inserting the following:
 - 30. Non-emergency elevator incident response, \$350.00 first hour or part thereof, per fire vehicle
