CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 272-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane east of Lansdowne Avenue extending between the public lane first north of Wallace Avenue to the public lane first south of Lappin Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane east of Lansdowne Avenue extending between the public lane first north of Wallace Avenue to the public lane first south of Lappin Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of;

FIRSTLY:

PIN 21312-0205 (LT).

Being part of Lot 47 in Block S on Plan M-88 designated as PART 2 on Plan 66R-18151, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

SECONDLY:

PIN 21312-0207 (LT).

Being part of Lot 46 in Block S on Plan M-88 designated as PART 4 on Plan 66R-18151, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

THIRDLY:

PIN 21312-0209 (LT).

Being part of Lot 46 in Block S on Plan M-88 designated as PART 6 on Plan 66R-18151, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66)

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
