BY-LAW No. 276-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane system in the block bounded by Earlscourt Avenue, Hatherly Road, Nairn Avenue and **Teignmouth Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane system in the block bounded by Earlscourt Avenue, Hatherly Road, Nairn Avenue and Teignmouth Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of York) and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of the One Foot Reserved lying to the west of Lots 113 to 125, inclusive, all on Plan 1442 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64), the boundaries of the land being described as follows:

COMMENCING at the south-easterly angle of the said Reserved, said point being the south-westerly angle of Lot 113 on the said Plan 1442;

THENCE westerly along the southerly limit of the said Reserved a distance of 0.30 metres, more or less, to the south-westerly angle of the said Reserved, said point being in the easterly limit of the Lane lying to the east of the easterly limits of Lots 18 to 6, inclusive, on Plan 1530, registered in the said Land Registry Office;

THENCE northerly along the westerly limit of the Reserved, being also the easterly limit of the said Lane on Plan 1530, a distance of 102.11 metres, more or less, to the south easterly angle of Lot 1 on the said Plan 1530;

THENCE easterly along the easterly production of the southerly limit of the said Lot 1 on Plan 1530 a distance of 0.30 metres, more or less, to the intersection with the easterly limit of the said Reserved on Plan 1442:

THENCE southerly along the easterly limit of the said Reserved a distance of 102.11 metres, more or less, the point of commencement

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
