CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 279-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land on the west side of Kipling Avenue south of Horner Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Kipling Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the west side of Kipling Avenue south of Horner Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 07588-0028 (LT).

Being parts of Lots 166, 167 and 168 on Plan 1026-York registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64) designated as PART 2 on Plan 66R-18654 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66)

in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Kipling Avenue.
