CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 283-2001

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Brock Avenue, Gilbert Avenue, Mackenzie Crescent, Salem Avenue, Somerset Avenue, Townsley Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Brock Avenue	West	A point 266 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north thereof	Anytime
Somerset Avenue	East	A point 61 metres south of Davenport Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Brock Avenue	West	A point 32.5 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
Gilbert Avenue	East	A point 176 metres south of Innes Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime

Mackenzie Crescent	West	A point 92 metres east of Lisgar Street and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime
Salem Avenue	East	A point 54 metres south of Dupont Street and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
Townsley Street	North	A point 29 metres west of Old Weston Road and a point 5.5 metres further west thereof	Anytime
