CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 342-2001

To appoint an Acting City Clerk.

WHEREAS according to sections 18 and 19 of the City of Toronto Act, 1997, the Council of the City of Toronto (the "Council") is deemed to have taken all steps required to appoint Novina Wong to the office of Clerk for the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS Novina Wong has retired from the office of Clerk for the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS subsection 73(1) of the *Municipal Act* requires the council of a municipality to appoint a clerk whose duties shall be those set out in subsection 73(1); and

WHEREAS subsection 73(3) of the Municipal Act allows the council to appoint a temporary acting clerk when the office of clerk is vacant, who shall have all the powers and duties of the clerk under the Act; and

WHEREAS Article II of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code sets out the powers and duties of the Clerk;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Effective June 1, 2001, the appointment of Novina Wong to the office of Clerk for the City of Toronto is rescinded.
- **2.** Effective June 1, 2001, Jeffrey A. Abrams is appointed to the office of Acting Clerk for the City of Toronto, and shall have all the powers and duties imposed upon the Clerk by Article II, of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
