**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 343-2001**

**To appoint an Interim Chief Financial Officer and City Treasurer.**

WHEREAS according to sections 18 and 19 of the City of Toronto Act, 1997, the Council of the City of Toronto (the "Council") is deemed to have taken all steps required to appoint Wanda Liczyk to the office of Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and to the office of collector for the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS Wanda Liczyk has resigned from the office of Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and to the office of collector for the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS subsection 77(1) of the *Municipal Act* requires the council of a municipality to appoint a treasurer whose duties shall be those set out in the Act; and

WHEREAS subsection 85(1) of the *Municipal Act* requires the council of every local municipality to appoint as many collectors for the municipality as it considers necessary; and

WHEREAS Article III of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code sets out the powers and duties of the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Effective June 1, 2001, the appointment of Wanda Liczyk to the office of Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and to the office of collector for the City of Toronto is rescinded.
2. Effective June 1, 2001, Michael R. Garrett is appointed to the office of Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and to the office of collector for the City of Toronto, and shall have all the powers and duties imposed upon the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and upon the collector by Article III of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
