BY-LAW No. 358-2001

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", respecting the alteration of Norway Avenue between Elmer Avenue and Woodbine Avenue by the installation of speed humps.
