BY-LAW No. 366-2001

**To amend Chapter 240, Traffic, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke
with respect to General stopping and parking regulations.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 240, Article 1, Section 7, subsection A of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke is amended by adding the following:
 - (6) No person shall, without specific authorization from the municipality, park any vehicle on any boulevard. This prohibition does not apply to any motor vehicle parked in the driveway of a single family residential dwelling where such a driveway leads to an attached garage, carport, rear yard parking stall, or front or side yard parking pad that has been authorized by the municipality.
