BY-LAW No. 388-2001

**To layout and dedicate certain lands for public highway purposes to form part of the
public highway Markham Road.**

WHEREAS the City has acquired certain lands as hereinafter described and the Council of the City deems it appropriate and necessary to accept the said lands as a Public Highway; and

WHEREAS Subsection 1(a) of Section 297, of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for establishing and layout out highways; and

WHEREAS Subsection 111 of Section 210, of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that by-laws may be passed by Councils of local municipalities to provide for surveying, settling and marking the boundary of highways and giving names to them;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described as Part of Block C on Plan M-1616 designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-19088, in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough), Part of PIN 06079-0041(LT) are hereby established and laid out as a public highway within the City to be known as Markham Road.
2. All By-laws presently in force with respect to highways and streets shall apply to the said highway created under this By-law.
