BY-LAW No. 390-2001

To amend Chapter 103, Heritage, of the Municipal Code to allow for a Member of Council to be appointed to the Collections, Conservation and Shared Resources Management Board.

WHEREAS the membership of Community Museum Management Boards includes one or two City Councillors, with the exception of 98 Atlantic Avenue, known as the Collections Conservation and Shared Resources Management Board; and

WHEREAS it is considered desirable that the membership of the Collections, Conservation and Shared Resources Management Board include a Member of Council; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2001, By-law No. 793-1999 has been codified as Article I, Museum Boards, of Chapter 103, Heritage, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A of Chapter 103, Heritage, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting "None" from the second row of the column headed "Number of Council Members" in Section B and substituting "One" in its place.
