BY-LAW No. 403-2001

**To designate certain lots on Registered Plan 2452 as being exempt from part lot control
(re: 101-113 Doris Avenue).**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act* to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the lands described in the attached Schedule "A".
2. This By-law expires one year from the date of its enactment by Council.
