BY-LAW No. 410-2001

To authorize the alteration of Spring Garden Avenue by the construction of a cul-de-sac west of Kenneth Avenue on Spring Garden Avenue and the re-opening of the Spring Garden Avenue cul-de-sac to Doris Avenue.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration of Spring Garden Avenue was published in a daily newspaper on April 26 and 30, 2001 and May 7 and 14, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 16, 2001 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

The following alteration is authorized:

1. The construction of a cul-de-sac west of Kenneth Avenue on Spring Garden Avenue and the re-opening of the Spring Garden Avenue cul-de-sac to Doris Avenue.
