CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 413-2001

To repeal By-law No. 1996-0490 of the former City of Toronto to authorize the removal of the four remaining traffic calming islands on Bartlett Avenue between Bloor Street West and Hallam Street.

WHEREAS By-law No. 1996-0490 of the former City of Toronto was amended by By-law No. 1997-0325 which by-law authorized the removal of one of five traffic calming islands on Bartlett Avenue between Bloor Street West and Hallam Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1996-0490 of the former City of Toronto, being “A By-law to further amend By-law No. 602-89, being ‘A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations’, respecting the alteration of Bartlett Avenue by the narrowing of the pavement between Bloor Street West and Hallam Street” is repealed.
