BY-LAW No. 414-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane system west of Brunswick Avenue extending southerly from Harbord Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane system west of Brunswick Avenue extending southerly from Harbord Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 23 on Plan 87 designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-15651, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
