**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 454-2001**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

(Column 1 Road)	(Column 2 Side)	(Column 3 Between)	( Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Orley Avenue	South	Chisholm Avenue and Oak Park Avenue	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in alphabetical order in lieu thereof the following:

(Column 1 Road)	( Column 2 Side)	(Column 3 Between)	(Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Orley Avenue	South	Westlake Avenue and Chisholm Avenue	Anytime

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
