BY-LAW No. 461-2001

To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII

1. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
Woodcroft Crescent	West	A point 15 metres north of Hatherley Road and a point 6 metres north thereof	Anytime

2. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3	Column 4
<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Prohibited Times or days</u>
Brookside Avenue	West	A point 18.3 metres north of St. John’s Road and a point 6 metres further north thereof	Anytime
Landour Avenue	East	A point 31.2 metres south of Hertford Avenue and a point 5.2 metres north thereof	Anytime
