CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 463-2001

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bertmount Avenue, Gainsborough Road, Linsmore Crescent, Lippincott Street, Patricia Drive, Shannon Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Lippincott Street	East	A point 63.5 metres north of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Bertmount Avenue	West	A point 9.5 metres south of Dundas Street East and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
Gainsborough Road	North	A point 81.0 metres east of Wembley Drive and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime
Linsmore Crescent	East	A point 44 metres north of Glebeholme Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north thereof	Anytime

Patricia Drive	West	A point 92.0 metres south of Keystone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
Shannon Street	North	A point 32.6 metres east of Dovercourt Road and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime
