CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 466-2001

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, respecting the appointment of certain employees of the Works and Emergency Services Department.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 150-7 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, is amended by deleting the definition of “Certified Officer (Parking Offences)” and substituting the following definition of “Certified Officer (Parking Offences)”:

CERTIFIED OFFICER (PARKING OFFENCES) – Any person employed by the City’s Works and Emergency Services Department who has been or who is hereafter certified by the Chief of the Toronto Police Service as competent for the purposes of enforcing one or more municipal parking by-laws within the City of Toronto or any specified part or parts thereof for any period set out in the certificate and whose certificate has not lapsed or been suspended or cancelled by the Chief.
