BY-LAW No. 471-2001

To amend By-law No. 232-2001 and to amend Chapter 400 of the former Toronto Municipal Code, the Traffic and Parking Code, a by-law of the former City of Toronto, respecting the designation of a private roadway at 190 Elizabeth Street as a fire route.

WHEREAS, pursuant to By-law No. 232-2001, the Council, among other things, designated the private roadway at 200 Elizabeth Street as a fire route; and

WHEREAS the applicant for such fire route has since informed the City that the address should have been 190 Elizabeth Street and has requested that By-law No. 232-2001 be amended to reflect this; and

WHEREAS the Fire Chief, through his duly authorized designate, has no objection to this amendment; and

WHEREAS otherwise the conditions established under Section 408.8 for the designation of the applicant's private roadway as a fire route remain satisfied for the amendment by the Council of the City of Toronto of Chapter 400 of the Former Toronto Municipal Code for the purpose of designating this private roadway as a fire route;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In this By-law, "former Toronto Municipal Code" has the same meaning given to that expression in By-law No. 232-2001.
2. The former Toronto Municipal Code is amended:
 - (a) by replacing in Schedule XXXIV (Route) of Section 400-87:
 - (49) Within the lands municipally known as 200 Elizabeth Street as shown on the plan attached as Appendix C-49 at the end of this Chapter.

with the following:

- (49) Within the lands municipally known as 190 Elizabeth Street as shown on the plan attached as Appendix C-49 at the end of this Chapter.

3. This amendment is retroactive to the date that By-law No. 232-2001 was enacted and passed.
4. In all other respects, By-law No. 232-2001 remains the same.
