**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 495-2001**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths,  
Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways with respect to bicycle lanes on Queens Quay West  
between Lower Portland Street and Lower Spadina Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Queens Quay West	North, adjacent to curb	Lower Spadina Avenue and Lower Portland Street

B. By adding to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Queens Quay West	North, adjacent to curb/lay-bys used for loading purposes	Lower Spadina Avenue and Lower Portland Street
