BY-LAW No. 508-2001

To amend Article I, Building Permits, of Municipal Code Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, to increase permit fees.

WHEREAS By-law No. 163-1998; "A By-law under the *Building Code Act, 1992* respecting permits and related matters", is codified as Article I, Building Permits, of Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 363, Building and Construction, Article I, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is deleted and the following substituted:

SCHEDULE A TO CH. 363, ART. I CLASSES OF PERMITS AND PERMIT FEES

1. <u>Calculation of Permit Fees</u>

Permit fees shall be calculated based on the formula given below, unless otherwise specified in this schedule:

Permit fee = SI x A

where: SI = Service Index for Classification of the work proposed A = floor area in m² of work involved.

2. <u>Minimum Fee</u>

A minimum fee of \$84 shall be charged for all work.

5. <u>OTHER APPLICABLE FEES</u>

Fees for classes of permits or services not described or included in this Schedule shall be based on an hourly charge of \$63 per hour to account for processing of the permit and inspections.

6. <u>REFUNDS</u>

ITEM

Pursuant to § 363-6C, the amount of fees refundable shall be calculated based on the total required fee, using the following factors:

- (a) 75 percent if application is cancelled prior to the review of the application and 50 percent if cancelled prior to permit issuance.
- (b) 40 percent if permit has been issued and project has been cancelled minus \$84 for each field inspection performed up to the cancellation date.
- (c) In cases where the deposit paid is less than the total required fee calculated using this Schedule, the amount of the refund shall be reduced by the amount owing.
- (d) No refund is due for any other charges paid under Section 4 of this Schedule A or for certification of plans.
- (e) If the amount of fees refundable as calculated pursuant to this section is less than the minimum permit fee applicable to the work, there shall be no refund.
- (f) The refund shall be made to the then current permit holder at the time the refund request is made.
- **2.** Transition.
- A. This by-law comes into force on August 1, 2001.
- B. Despite Subsection A, if an application for a permit for a work was accepted by the Chief Building Official under the *Building Code Act, 1992* before the coming into force of this by-law, the permit fees for the application shall be calculated in accordance with Schedule A as it read before the coming into force of this by-law.
