BY-LAW No. 555-2001

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", respecting the alteration of Crawford Street at between Bloor Street West and Barton Street by narrowing the pavement.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on May 25, 28, June 4 and 11, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on June 12, 2001 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;
