BY-LAW No. 560-2001

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, to establish bicycle lanes on Runnymede Road from Bloor Street West to St. Clair Avenue West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Runnymede Road	North, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and St. Clair Avenue West
Runnymede Road	South, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and St. Clair Avenue West
