BY-LAW No. 564-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Lakeshore Boulevard West, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parcel 25-16 in the Register for Section B-1176.

Being composed of part of Lot 25 on Plan 1176-York registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64) designated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-18800 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Lakeshore Boulevard West.
