BY-LAW No. 569-2001

**To amend further By-law No. 271, a By-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of
certain highways”, being a By-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of By-law No. 271, entitled “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, as amended, being a By-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

King Edward Avenue	North and East	Gledhill Avenue and Lumsden Avenue	January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
