**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 603-2001**

**To amend further By-law No. 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto  
respecting pensions and other benefits.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 32i of By-law No. 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law “To provide pensions and death benefits to members of the Metropolitan Police Force”, as such section was enacted by By-law No. 82-88 and amended by By-laws Nos. 83-92 and 149-97 of that former Municipality, and by By-law No. 672-1999, is further amended by;
  - (a) striking out in subsection (1) thereof,
    - (i) “July 1, 1992” in the first line thereof and substituting therefor “January 1, 2000”; and
    - (ii) “\$375.00” in the first line of clause (a) thereof and substituting in lieu thereof “\$500.00”;
  - (b) striking out, in subsection (2) thereof, “section 32s” and substituting therefor “subsections 32t(3) and (4)”.

ENACTED AND PASSED by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting this 28th day of June, A.D. 2001.
