## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## **BY-LAW No. 606-2001**

## To amend former City of North York By-law No. 30788 to permit the erection of one off-premise sign on W. R. Allen Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Former City of North York By-law No. 30788 is amended by adding the following section immediately after section 4.10:

## "4.11 SITE-SPECIFIC EXCEPTION – W. R. ALLEN ROAD, NORTH OF TRANSIT ROAD

Sections 2.9.6, 2.9.11, 2.9.15 and 3.7.1 do not apply to prohibit the erection or display of one single-faced ground sign featuring animated video copy within the untravelled portion of the W. R. Allen road allowance at the location shown in Schedule "D" to this by-law for the purposes of third party advertising and community information if:

- (i) the area of the sign is not more than twenty-two and eight-tenths (22.8) square metres;
- (ii) the height of the sign is not more than nine and seven-tenths (9.7) metres;
- (iii) the sign is not erected or displayed as a flag, banner, or pennant and is not made of cloth, plastic or similar flexible material;
- (iv) all sign surfaces are sealed or covered in a manner that prevents the exposure of all mechanics, electronics, internal sign elements and minimizes corrosion;
- (v) appropriate deflectors are added to the sign to ensure it does not impact on local residents."
- **2.** By-law No. 30788 is amended by adding as Schedule "D" the map attached to this by-law.

**3.** This by-law shall come into force upon the filing with the City Clerk of a certificate by the City Solicitor attesting to the execution of the necessary agreements for the use of the lands upon which the sign is to be erected.
