BY-LAW No. 661-2001

To amend Chapter 910, Parking Machines, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code with respect to parking machines on certain streets within the City of Toronto.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by:

(1) Deleting the following from Schedule I in alphabetical order:

(Highway)	(Side Parking)	(Between)	(Hours)	(Fee/Time Limit)	(Maximum Parking Period)
Mercer Street	South	Entire length	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday	\$2.00 for 1 hour	2 hours
Mercer Street	South	Entire length	6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday	\$2.00 for 1 hour	3 hours

(2) Adding the following to Schedule I in alphabetical order:

(Highway)	(Side Parking)	(Between)	(Hours)	(Fee/Time Limit)	(Maximum Parking Period)
Mercer Street	South	Blue Jays Way and a point 53.6 metres west of John Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday	\$2.00 for 1 hour	2 hours
