CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 664-2001

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Front Yard Parking.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

By inserting new Subsections (4.2), (4.3) and (4.4) after Subsection (4.1) in § 400-9D of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, as follows:

- (4.2) Notwithstanding any other provision of § 400-9D, the provisions respecting front yard parking in former Ward 25 (Don River) apply to those sections of Ward 30 (Toronto-Danforth) which previously formed part of Ward 26 (East Toronto);
- (4.3) Notwithstanding any other provision of § 400-9D, the provisions respecting front yard parking in former Ward 24 (Downtown) apply to those sections of Ward 20 (Trinity-Spadina)and those sections of new Ward 27 which previously formed part of Ward 23 (Midtown);
- (4.4) Notwithstanding any other provision of § 400-9D, the provisions respecting front yard parking in former Ward 20 (Trinity-Niagara) apply to those sections of Ward 19 (Trinity-Spadina) which previously formed part of Ward 21 (Davenport).
