BY-LAW No. 692-2001

To amend By-law No. 378-2000, being “A By-law to further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being ‘A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations’, respecting the alteration of Windermere Avenue from Bloor Street West to Annette Street by the installation of speed humps” to replace the Drawing to reflect changes to the location of the speed hump installations.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 378-2000, being “A By-law to further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being ‘A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations’, respecting the alteration of Windermere Avenue from Bloor Street West to Annette Street by the installation of speed humps” is amended:
 - (1) by deleting from Column 6 (Column 6 – Drawing No./Date) of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following: “dated October, 1999” and replacing it with: “revised June, 2001”.
