BY-LAW No. 746-2001

To authorize the sale of a part of the closed portion of the highway Wilson Heights Boulevard located on the northwest corner of Wilson Heights Boulevard and Waterloo Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a part of the closed portion of the highway Wilson Heights Boulevard located on the northwest corner of Wilson Heights Boulevard and Waterloo Avenue be sold, upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 3 of North York Community Council Report No. 6, as amended and adopted by Council at its meeting held on July 24, 25 and 26, 2001; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to sell the said portion of closed highway was published in The Toronto Sun on August 22, 29, September 5 and 12, 2001 and no one who claimed that the person's land would be prejudicially affected by the said by-law applied to be heard;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The soil and freehold of a part of the closed portion of the highway Wilson Heights Boulevard located on the northwest corner of Wilson Heights Boulevard and Waterloo Avenue, described as follows:

In the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of York) and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Wilson Heights Boulevard dedicated by Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 217-72 (Instrument Number NY628023), being part of Lot 70, Plan 1899, designated as Part 2 on Plan RS-1061, save and except for Part 4 on Plan 64R-17039, the said part of Wilson Heights Boulevard being closed by Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 37-79 (Instrument NY756195) shall be sold, upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 3 of North York Community Council Report No. 6, as amended and adopted by Council at its meeting held on July 24, 25 and 26, 2001.
