BY-LAW No. 791-2001

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Hanna Road and Glenvale Boulevard” and “Hanna Road and McRae Drive” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1
Intersections)

(In Column 2
Stop Streets)

Hanna Road and Leacrest Road

On Hanna Road, north of Leacrest Road

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
