BY-LAW No. 805-2001

To authorize the alteration of Yorkdale Road at Highway 401 by the installation of a transit lay-by and the widening of Yorkdale Road to permit the addition of an additional lane.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Yorkdale Road north of Highway 401 by the installation of a transit lay-by and the widening of Yorkdale Road for the installation of an additional lane and certain other modifications was published in a daily newspaper on August 21, 28, September 4 and 11, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 12, 2001 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

Installation of southbound transit lay-by on west side of Yorkdale Road, north of Highway 401 on ramp; installation of bus shelter and waiting area on land to be acquired; widening Yorkdale Road for the installation of additional inbound lane on west leg of intersection; modifications of existing centre medians and curb radius on northwest and southwest corners, as set out on Drawing No. 6469-20 dated March 8, 2001.
