BY-LAW No. 806-2001

To authorize the alteration of Atlantic Avenue, between Liberty Street and Hanna Avenue, by narrowing the pavement.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding alteration of Atlantic Avenue, between Liberty Street and Hanna Avenue, by narrowing the pavement was published in a daily newspaper on August 21 and 28, September 4 and 11, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 12, 2001 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

Atlantic Avenue, between Liberty Street and Hanna Avenue, by narrowing the pavement form a width of 11.0 metres to a width of 9.3 metres on the east side, as set out on Drawing No. M-2915-2 dated June, 2001.
