BY-LAW No. 807-2001

To authorize the alteration of Roncesvalles Avenue at The Queensway/Queen Street West by narrowing the pavement.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding alteration of Roncesvalles Avenue at The Queensway/Queen Street West by narrowing the pavement was published in a daily newspaper on August 29, September 4, 11 and 18, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 12, 2001 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

Roncesvalles Avenue at The Queensway/Queen Street West by narrowing the pavement, and extending the sidewalk from a width of approximately 2 metres to a width of approximately 4.3 metres on the west side of Roncesvalles Avenue from The Queensway to a point approximately 61 metres further north, as set out on Drawing No. M-4310-4 dated March 15, 2001.
