**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 810-2001**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Lake Shore Boulevard West (M.T. 2)	Between the east curb line of Fort York Boulevard and a point 30.5 metres west of the west curb line of Fort York Boulevard

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Dundas Street West (M.T. 8)	North	A point 21.2 metres east of the east curb line of Palmerston Avenue and a point 8.0 metres further east thereof	9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturday, except Public Holidays

3. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

Lake Shore Boulevard West (M.T. 2) and Fort York Boulevard	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
