**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 811-2001**

**To amend By-law No. 307, a by-law “To designate certain locations in the Borough of East York as pedestrian crossovers”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule “A” of By-law No. 307, entitled “To designate certain locations in the Borough of East York as pedestrian crossovers”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Dawes Road” and “Donlands Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Immediately north of its intersection with  
Chapman Avenue

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
