**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 812-2001**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Oak Park Avenue” and “Orley Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(Column 1 Highway)	(Column 2 Side)	(Column 3 Between)	(Column 4 Time or Days)
Oak Park Avenue	West	A point 55 metres south of Westbrook Avenue and a point 11.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
