BY-LAW No. 833-2001

To amend the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 118 respecting 279 Yonge Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** By-law No. 118, being a By-law "Respecting Signs over Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is further amended by adding the following section:
 - 2H. Notwithstanding Section 2A of this By-law, signs extending over the south limit of Dundas Square and east limit of Yonge Street adjacent to a structure to be erected on lands municipally known in the year 2000 as 279 Yonge Street and located within 1.5 metres of the south-east corner of Yonge Street and Dundas Square, may be permitted provided:
 - (a) the overhead clearance of the sign is at least 3.9 metres above the level of the sidewalk and extending for a further height of not more than 6.7 metres and the sign does not extend more than 1.5 metres over the street line; and
 - (b) there is compliance with the requirements respecting the erection or alteration of signs specified in Sections 2 and 3.
