BY-LAW No. 846-2001

To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII

1. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Lapp Street	East	A point 96 metres south of Northland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres south thereof	from 7:00 p.m. on the 1st day of each month to 7:00 p.m. on the 16th day of each month, April 1st to December 1st, inclusive
Lapp Street	West	A point 101 metres south of Northland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres south thereof	from 7:00 p.m. on the 16th day of each month to 7:00 p.m. on the 1st day of each month, April 1st to December 1st, inclusive
Lapp Street	West	A point 101 metres south of Northland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres south thereof	Anytime, from 7:00 p.m. on the 1st day December to 7:00 p.m. on the 1st day of April, inclusive
