BY-LAW No. 862-2001

To amend By-law No. 226-1998 to terminate the interim appointment of Paula Dill as the Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto.

WHEREAS By-law No. 226-1998, "To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto", has been amended by By-laws Nos. 10-1999, 95-2001 and 201-2001; and

WHEREAS sections 2 and 4 and subsections 3(3) and (4) of By-law No. 226-1998 respecting the duties and responsibilities of the Chief Building Official and Deputy Chief Building Officials are now codified in §§ 169-48, 169-49, and 169-50 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS Council has authorized the appointment of a new Chief Building Official with the appointment effective November 5, 2001;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law No. 226-1998, "To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto", as amended, is amended as follows:
 - A. By renumbering section 1 as subsection 1(1); and
 - B. By adding the following:
 - (2) Subsection (1) remains in full force and effect until a by-law appointing a new Chief Building Official comes into effect, and when that by-law comes into effect the appointment of Paula Dill as Chief Building Official shall terminate.
