BY-LAW No. 893-2001

To amend further By-law No. 271, a by-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule ‘I’ of By-law No. 271, entitled “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Dunkirk Road” and “Eldon Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Highway	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Prohibited Months
East York Avenue	West	Mortimer Avenue to MacPhail Avenue	May, July, September, and November
East York Avenue	East	Mortimer Avenue to MacPhail Avenue	January, February, March, April, June, August, October, and December

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
