**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 922-2001**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Dufferin Street (M.T. 15)	East	Beaver Avenue and Ascot Avenue	Anytime
Dufferin Street (M.T. 15)	West	MacKay Avenue and a point 40.0 metres south of St. Clair Avenue West	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Dufferin Street (M.T. 15)	East	Beaver Avenue and Rosemount Avenue	Anytime

2. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:
