BY-LAW No. 946-2001

To authorize the alteration of Scott Road at its intersection with Cameron Avenue by narrowing the intersection.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Scott Road at its intersection with Cameron Avenue by narrowing the pavement was published in a daily newspaper on May 1, 8, 15 and 22, 2000 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 23, 2000 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Scott Road is altered at its intersection with Cameron Avenue by narrowing the roadway from a width of 8.5 metres to a width varying from 5.25 metres at its narrowest opening on the west side of Scott Road from Cameron Avenue to a point 14 metres south generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-6205 dated November, 2001, to be filed with the City Clerk.
