CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1006-2001

To amend Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the Municipal Code of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto to establish an offence for parking vehicles other than motorcycles in designated motorcycle parking spaces.

WHEREAS City Council has approved the designation of certain parking spaces within the City of Toronto for use by motorcycles only; and

WHEREAS City Council has directed that the City Solicitor make application to the Ministry of the Attorney-General for the establishment of set fines for enforcement of these designations;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the Municipal Code of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto is amended by:

A. Adding the following to subsection 400-11B(1) in numerical order:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
400-33J (motorcycle parking)	20.00	30.00

B. Adding the following to subsection 400-11B(3) in numerical order:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
400-33J (motorcycle parking)	20.00	30.00

C. Adding the following subsection to § 400-33:

J. Where authorized signs to that effect are displayed, no person shall park any vehicle, other than a motorcycle as defined in Subsection 400-42H(6) of this chapter, in any space designated for motorcycle parking only.
