BY-LAW No. 1053-2001

To authorize the alteration of certain highways by the construction of a traffic circle incorporating all legs of Windermere Avenue, Coe Hill Drive and Budgell Terrace and the residential section of Windermere Avenue; and narrowing Winderemere Avenue south of Coe Hill Drive.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of portions of Windermere Avenue, Coe Hill Drive, Budgell Terrace was published in a daily newspaper on October 29, November 5, 12 and 19, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on November 20, 2001 and it is appropriate to permit the construction;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of a traffic circle incorporating all legs of Windermere Avenue, Coe Hill Drive and Budgell Terrace and the residential section of Windermere Avenue; and narrowing Windermere Avenue to 8.5 metres south of Coe Hill Drive, as shown on the drawing "Intersection Improvement - Windermere Avenue" dated August 28, 2001 on file with the City Clerk.
