BY-LAW No. 1062-2001

To rename Sweepster Court between Huntingwood Drive and Bridlewood Boulevard as “Acara Court”.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the highway renaming was published in a daily newspaper on October 29, November 5, 12 and 19, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on November 20, 2001;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Sweepster Court between Huntingwood Drive and Bridlewood Boulevard, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06141-0166 (LT).

Sweepster Court on Plan 66M-2359.

Metropolitan Toronto Land Titles Division (No. 66)

City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario

is renamed Acara Court.
